This Winter, Surrey County Council, district, borough and town and parish councils have been working together with Surrey's fantastic faith and community groups to open up a network of Warm Hubs that are there to support residents who will be affected by the cost-of-living and energy crisis.

Many millions of UK residents will be affected by soaring energy bills, and Surrey is no different, with tens of thousands of our neighbours, friends, and families being forced to make difficult decisions on whether to heat their homes or eat three meals a day.

We know that many of our homes are poorly insulated and this, combined with the extreme types of weather we've been seeing, because of climate change, means that this winter could be even harder. The combination of adverse weather, poorly heated homes, and people unable to keep

their heating on, poses a real threat to people's health.

That is why a network of Warm Hubs has been set up across Surrey to provide support to residents in these challenging times. The Warm Hubs are spaces across the county, where people can drop-in, get warm, have a hot drink and be in the company of other people. Very simply, it is a place to get warm. There will also be people on hand to give free energy advice at some of the hubs.
